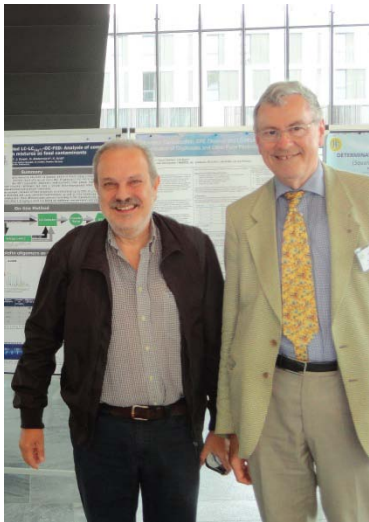


20/04/2015 - **A CNR-IIA researcher elected vicepresident of IAEAC**
